STATUS OF CHRISTIANITY TODAY

FROM CHURCH TO DANCE CLUB

Due to the decline of people attending the services, church buildings run empty and the position of the church building is under a great deal of pressure all over Europe. Churches are closing down more often because of the small number of believers attending services, and a lack of money to maintain the often monumental buildings.

Now, instead of renovating and re-establishing the buildings, the focus has shifted to new uses for churches. Bars, skateparks, festivals, dance clubs, and bookshops - the list of the new purposes for the usage of the church buildings can go on and on. In the Netherlands alone, almost every big city has a project involving the reuse of their church buildings.





In recent years much has changed in European identity. In the founding of Europe, Christianity played a major role. An example of this is the establishment of the constitution and the culture of the people in European countries.

Today, at the beginning of the 21st century, most Europeans have become content with a largely secularised society that values religion less and emphasises humanism. In the new secular age of Europe there has been a dramatic decrease in church attendance. In the Netherlands alone, 55% of the population never attends church.

The European continent was once the home of the majority of the world's Christians, but in a recent study conducted on youth, it was found that many between the ages of 16 and 29 claim they have no religious affiliation. In general, a high percentage of young people throughout Europe never attend religious services, never pray and don't identify with any religious group.

Between 70 and 80 percent of all young people in the Netherlands say they have no religious beliefs.

RE:VIVAL

The main cause of the consequences of Christianity today, according to research is the rise of humanism and secularity. With the rise of science and more knowledge after the time of war, people started to place their trust in things they could control themselves, this as well as the freedom of shifting the standards of a community based on the agreement of the masses.

Survival became a smaller point of concern for the western world, especially Europe. People grew increasingly independent on the wisdom provided by a sovereign deity, God, and therefore lost their foundation in the word of God and therefore faith in God.

RE:ACTIVATE

By Reconnecting and Restoring faith, (youth) members can be reactivated into devoting their lives to God and Christ, volunteering in local churches and christian organisations.

New Heaven New Earth is a church that practices faith in accordance with the Bible, prays in the name of Jesus, and offers worship services to God.

The official name of New Heaven New Earth, SCJ Church of Jesus is “Shincheonji Church of Jesus, the Temple of the Tabernacle of the Testimony.” Shincheonji is a Korean word meaning “New Heaven and New Earth (Rv 21:1).” This refers to a new tabernacle and a new group of believers (Is 65:17, Is 66:22, 2Pet 3:13). As promised in the Bible, NHNE consists of 12 tribes (Mt 6:10, Rv 4, Rv 7) spread across more than 30 different countries worldwide. In Europe alone there are 11 churches spread across 9 countries.

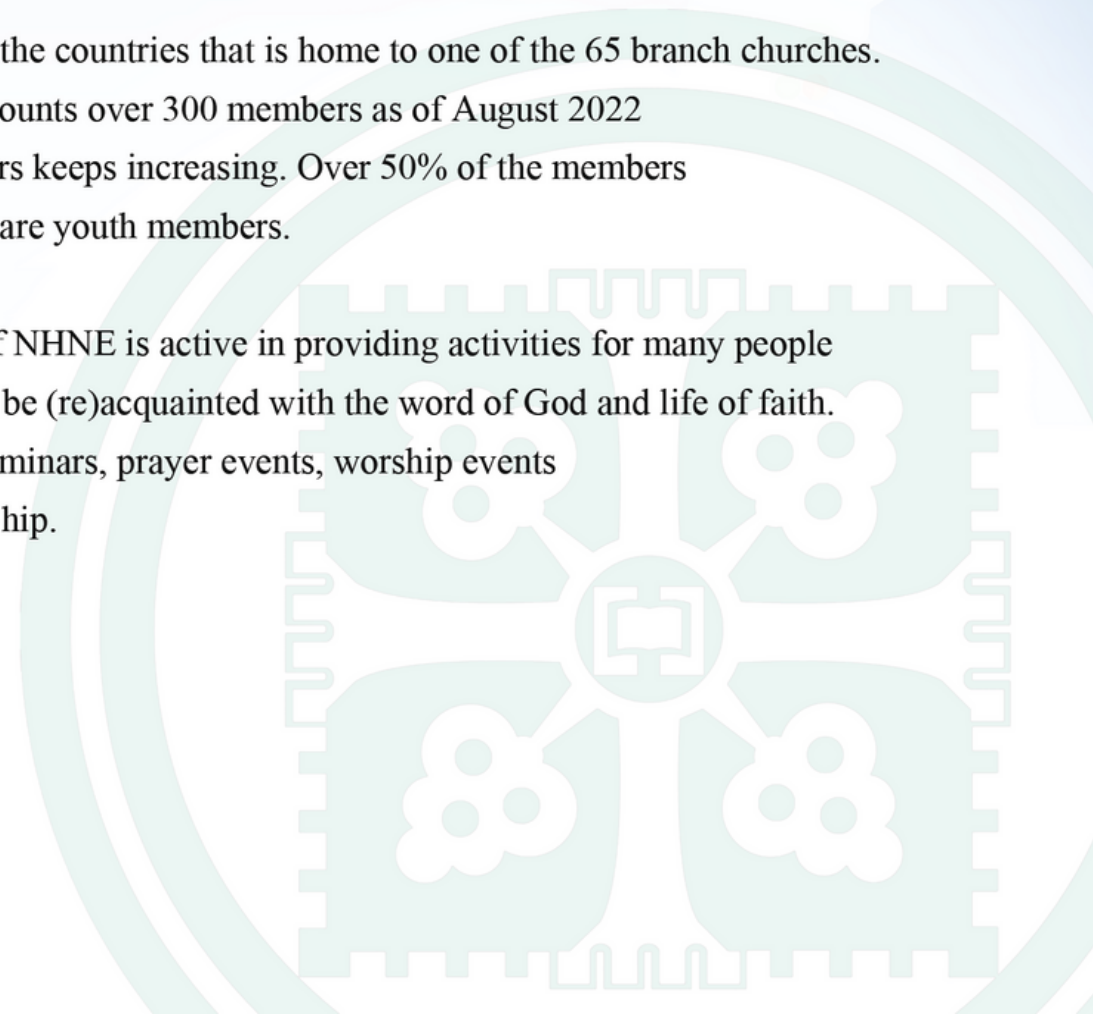

The Netherlands is one of the countries that is home to one of the 65 branch churches. The Netherlands Church counts over 300 members as of August 2022 and the number of members keeps increasing. Over 50% of the members in the Netherlands branch are youth members.

The Netherlands branch of NHNE is active in providing activities for many people to offer the opportunity to be (re)acquainted with the word of God and life of faith. These activities include seminars, prayer events, worship events and other forms of fellowship.

REVIVING OUR FOUNDATION

What is the foundation of faith, why do we believe in God? Christians believe that God is the entity that has created heaven and earth, but the foundation of why we believe in God involves the promises God has made to his people.

To revive the foundation of faith, NHNE strives to educate (and remind) people of the promises (prophecies) God has made to those who follow Him, and inform people of all the promises he has already fulfilled and is fulfilling to this day!

God promising beforehand, and fulfilling it over a course of many years exactly as spoken, proves His existence beyond a doubt, strengthening the faith of those who understand.

NHNE provides a Bible-based educational course that teaches the physical fulfilment of God's prophecies. Currently, it provides online courses that are broadcasted worldwide in many different languages. This course is divided into three levels.

First, one learns the true meaning of the parables recorded throughout the Bible. After this, the general knowledge of the Bible is taught, and the course concludes with the testimony of the book of Revelation.

WORKING TOGETHER AS ONE

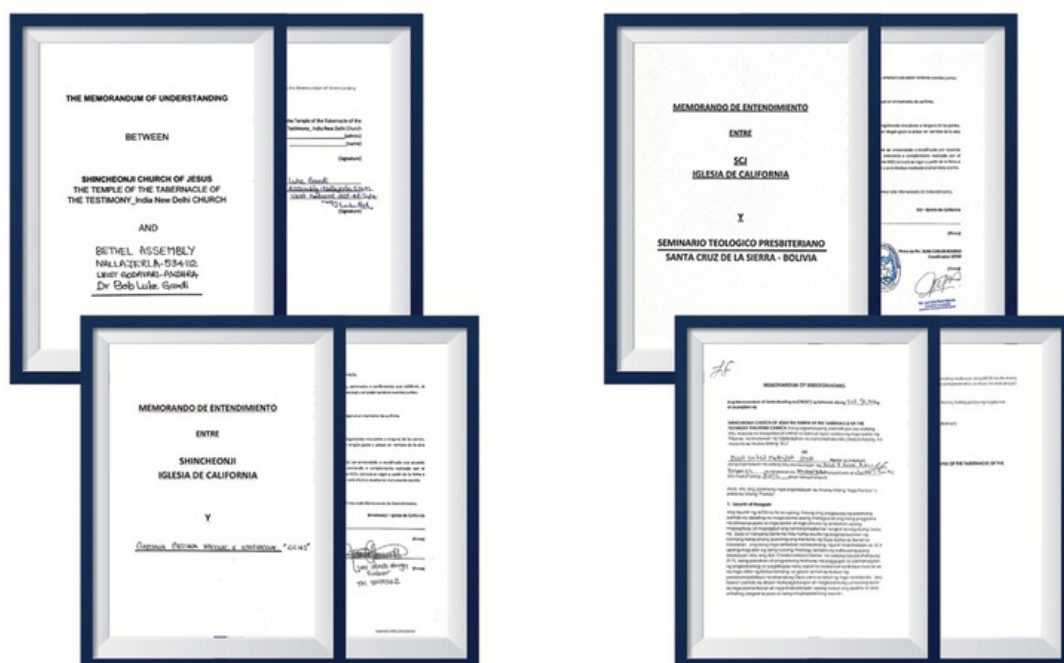
Reviving the faith in the world of Christianity is a noble but extremely large cause, and NHNE is well aware that it is only possible when the Christian bodies are working together. To make the collaboration something tangible, NHNE strives to sign MOU's with said organisations.

MOU stands for Memorandum of Understanding. A Memorandum of Understanding is an agreement between two or more parties outlined in a formal document.

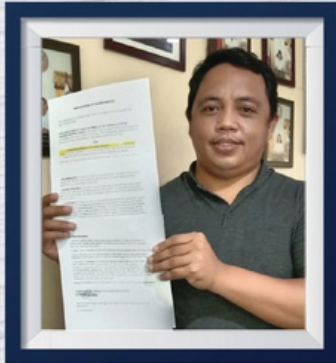
This agreement is not legally binding but signals the willingness of the parties to move forward with a contract.

As of August 2022 NHNE has established MOU's with over 2155 pastors, 22 seminary schools, and 958 churches in 67 countries.

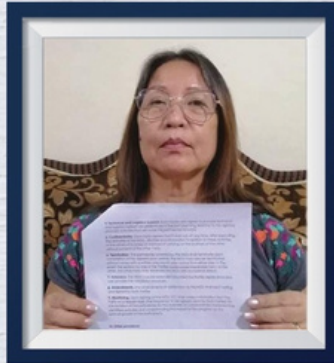
The establishment of an MOU is very important, since it signifies the dedication to the collaboration and support agreed upon between NHNE and the respective Christian organisation.



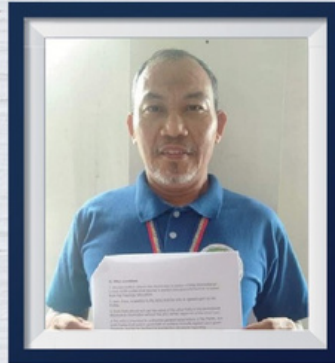
MOU WITH PASTORS ALL OVER THE WORLD



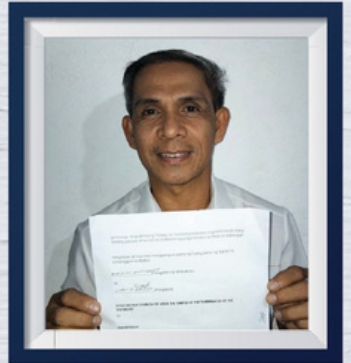
Philippine, Spring of Life church



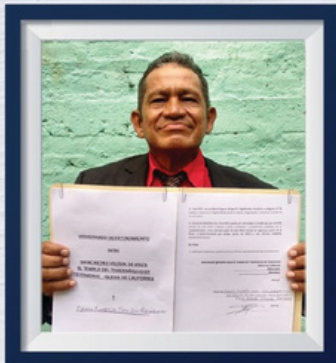
Philippine, Savior church



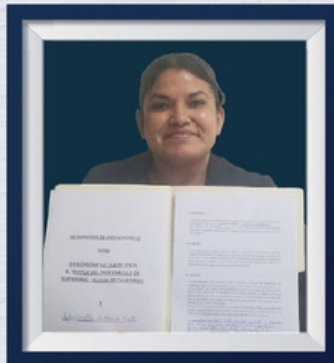
Philippine, Jesus Family church

El Salvador, Almighty God church



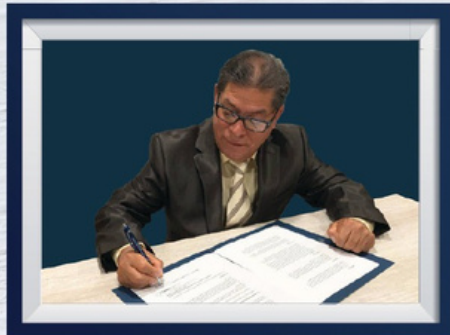
